From the desk of Pastor Andy Thompson



I can't believe that the first month of the year has already passed and Lent is just around the corner. February is going to be a special time. Not only will we begin the journey to the cross, but it is also Black History Month. Throughout the month we will feature stories about contributions made by Black Americans to the church, culture, and society.

A couple of weeks ago the lectionary gave us a passage from the 18th chapter of Deuteronomy as part of our scripture reflection. In the passage, God promises to send a prophet, and not just any prophet but one who come from among their own people and speak just as God commands.

Today we may wonder where those prophets have gone. Where are the great preachers and prophets of old who challenge the establishment and call the people back to faithfulness. The truth is the prophetic voice of God is all around us. It is found in the word of God and revealed to us in the life and ministry of Jesus. Today we don't have the office of prophet, even though we are just as hungry for both a word from God and a mediator. Today, we understand that life-giving and lifesaving mediator to be Christ.

The word of God comes to us in many ways and through a variety of experiences. Martin Luther King Jr. in his "I Have a Dream" speech, offers these words, I think prophetic words...

I have a dream today, I have a dream that one day, down in Alabama...black boys and black girls will be able to join hands with little white boys and girls as sisters and brothers. I have a dream today. I have a dream that one day every valley shall be exalted, every hill and mountain shall be made low, the rough places will be made plain, and the crooked places will be made straight, and the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together.


We don't have to worry about where God's prophetic voice is going to come from. God provides the leader and the words spoken, just as he did with Dr. King, just as he had done with the prophets of old and those today. All we must do is listen for God's word and then hope and dream for the time when Christ, the mediator, reveals the glory of the Lord to us. Then and only then will the rough places be made smooth, and the crooked places made straight. Then we shall all see the glory of the Lord together. Thanks be to God. *See you in church!*





If you would like to donate flowers for the altar, please contact the church office (901-363-1859) to sign up. You may reserve any Sunday this year, except during the Advent season.






